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AmiVoice Talk Mouse Terms of Use (“Terms”)

(Application of these Terms)

Article 1: These Terms define the conditions for the provision of AmiVoice Talk Mouse (hereinafter referred to as "Service") provided by Advanced Media, Inc. (hereinafter referred to as "the Company").

(Definition of Terms)

Article 2: In these Terms, the following terms are used with the following meanings:

- (1) "App" refers to the terminal application and Windows application used to utilize the Service.
- (2) "Customer" refers to the person using the Service.
- (3) "Voice Recognition Function" refers to the function that converts the Customer's voice data input on the App into text data.
- (4) "Summarization Function" refers to the function that uses the Azure OpenAI Service provided by Microsoft Corporation to summarize the text data generated from the voice data input by Customer into the App.
- (5) "Transmission Data" refers to the text data sent from the App to the Azure OpenAI Service for the Customer to use the Summarization Function.
- (6) "Summarized Data" refers to the data generated on the Azure OpenAI Service as a result of using the Summarization Function and then returned to the App.

(Agreement to these Terms)

Article 3: Customers shall use the Service in accordance with the provisions of these Terms. If the Service is actually used, it is deemed that the Customer has given valid and irrevocable consent to these Terms.

(Changes to these Terms)

Article 4: The Company may change these Terms at any time if deemed necessary by the Company.

2. The revised Terms shall take effect from the time they are posted in an appropriate location

within the Service or on the Company's website (hereinafter referred to as "Company's Website"), and the Customer shall be deemed to have given valid and irrevocable consent to the revised Terms by continuing to use the Service after the changes.

(Conditions for Providing the Service)

Article 5: Customers must prepare the necessary information terminals, communication devices, communication means, and power at their own expense and responsibility to use the Service.

2. The Company may change, modify, or discontinue the content (including specifications, design, and all other aspects) of all or part of the Service at any time without prior notice to the Customer if deemed necessary by the Company.
3. If changes or modifications are made to the App, these Terms shall apply to the use of the App after the changes or modifications.

(Service Content and Usage Conditions)

Article 6: The Company grants the Customer a non-transferable, non-sublicensable, non-exclusive right to use the App in providing the Service.

2. Intellectual property rights and all other rights related to the Service and the App provided by the Company do not transfer to the Customer, and only the above usage rights are granted to the Customer.
3. The Voice Recognition Function sends the voice to the Service server (hereinafter referred to as "Server") for recognition. Therefore, depending on the congestion status of the Server, it may take time to respond.
4. The Company may use the Customer's voice data input into the App, the text data generated from the voice, and word registration data for research and development and quality improvement of the Company's products and services. In this case, the voice and text data will not be publicly disclosed and will be strictly managed. Also, it will not be used in a form that can identify individuals.
5. Customers can make inquiries regarding the Service or the App from the Company's Website, and the Company shall take necessary actions in response to the inquiries. Individual inquiries by email, phone, or visit will not be handled.

(Prohibited Acts)

Article 7: Customers shall not engage in the following acts when using the Service:

- (1) Transfer, lend, or otherwise transfer or license the usage rights of the App to a third party.
- (2) Copy, duplicate, modify, or make additions to the App.

- (3) Change, reverse engineer, disassemble, decompile, or engage in similar acts regarding the App.
- (4) Tamper with information related to the Service.
- (5) Transmit or write harmful computer programs, etc.
- (6) Infringe on the property, honor, privacy, etc., of a third party or the Company.
- (7) Collect personal information of a third party or the Company without consent or by fraudulent means.
- (8) Interfere with the use or provision of the Service.
- (9) Infringe on the copyrights or other intellectual property rights of a third party or the Company.
- (10) Repeatedly make similar or identical inquiries more than necessary, make unreasonable demands to the Company, or otherwise interfere with the operation of the Service by the Company or the use of the Service by a third party, causing hindrance.
- (11) Engage in acts that violate laws or public order and morals.
- (12) Damage the Company's credibility or cause harm to the Company.
- (13) Engage in other acts deemed inappropriate by the Company.

(Temporary Suspension)

Article 8: The Company may suspend the provision of the Service in the event of the following occurrences and will notify or report to the Customer in an appropriate manner.

- (1) When addressing failures of equipment necessary for providing the Service
 - (2) When unavoidable due to operational or technical reasons
 - (3) When the Service cannot be provided due to force majeure such as natural disasters
2. In addition to the provisions of the preceding paragraph, the Company may temporarily suspend the provision of the Service after notifying the Customer in advance for regular inspections of equipment necessary for providing the Service.
3. The Company shall not be liable for any inconvenience, disadvantage, loss, or damage incurred by the Customer due to the inability to provide the Service for the reasons specified in the preceding two paragraphs.

(Discontinuation of the Service)

Article 9: The Company may discontinue the Service if any of the following conditions are met.

- (1) If the discontinuation of the Service is notified on the Company's Website at least 60 days before the discontinuation date
- (2) If the provision of the Service becomes impossible due to force majeure such as natural

disasters

(Summarization Function)

Article 10: The Customer acknowledges that the technology used in the Summarization Function analyzes Transmission Data using artificial intelligence (AI) language recognition technology, and may not accurately grasp the Customer's intent. The Company does not guarantee the accuracy, completeness, appropriateness, or usefulness of any information related to the Summarization Function and Summarized Data, and shall not be liable for any inconvenience, disadvantage, or any impact incurred by the Customer.

2. The Customer shall confirm at their own responsibility that they have lawful and legitimate authority to provide Transmission Data and that such provision does not violate laws or contracts with third parties. The Company does not guarantee these matters and shall not be liable for any damages arising from them.

3. If the use of the Azure OpenAI Service becomes unavailable, the Summarization Function may also become unusable, but the Company shall not be liable for any damages incurred by the Customer as a result.

4. Transmission data and Summarized Data will not be used by Microsoft Corporation for research and development, quality improvement, or machine learning of its products and services.

(Fees, etc.)

Article 11: This App is available for free, but some features or content are provided through in-app purchases. In-app purchases are made through the payment system provided by Apple Inc.'s App Store. Please check the content, price, and information displayed in the App or on the App Store for features and content provided through purchases. Refunds after purchases are processed according to the regulations set by Apple Inc. The Company does not handle refunds, so please be aware of this in advance.

(Confidentiality)

Article 12: The Company shall not use the information provided by the Customer in connection with the use of the Service for purposes other than the operation, management, and maintenance of the Service (including tuning for quality improvement of the Company's products and services), nor disclose it to any third party.

2. Notwithstanding the provisions of the preceding paragraph, the Company may disclose confidential information entrusted by the Customer if required by law or requested by authorities. In this case, the Company shall notify the Customer of the disclosure in advance

unless it violates relevant laws, and if prior notification cannot be made, it shall be done promptly afterward.

3. The provisions of this Article shall remain effective even after the termination of the Service.

(Customer's Responsibility)

Article 13: If the Customer causes damage to the Company due to reasons attributable to the Customer, the Customer shall notify the Company and compensate for the damages incurred by the Company.

2. If the Customer causes damage to a third party through the use of the Service, or if a dispute arises between the Customer and a third party, the Customer shall resolve it at their own responsibility and expense, and the Company shall not be liable for any responsibility. The same applies if the Customer suffers damage from a third party in connection with the use of the Service.

(Disclaimer)

Article 14: The Company does not guarantee that there are no errors in voice recognition related to the Service, and the Customer shall use the Service at their own responsibility and judgment.

2. The Company shall not be liable for any damages incurred by the Customer arising from the use or inability to use the Service, regardless of the legal cause of action.

3. The Company shall not be liable for any loss, damage, inconvenience, or disadvantage incurred by the Customer related to the disappearance or deletion of data accumulated on the Server, regardless of the cause, such as system failure or equipment failure.

(Governing Law and Jurisdiction)

Article 15: These Terms shall be governed by Japanese law.

2. All disputes related to the Service or these Terms shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the Tokyo District Court.
